

# Paradise Junior High Chapter of the National Beta Club

## By Laws

1. The name of this organization shall be the Paradise Junior High Chapter of the National Beta Club.
2. The time and place of meetings shall be decided by the primary sponsor (school employee designated by the principal)
3. The time of the meeting shall be the second Wednesday of each month immediately after school in the Junior High Library.
4. The purpose of this organization shall be the promotion of scholarship, leadership, and good citizenship at Paradise Junior High.
5. The initial membership (invitation into the club) shall be made to students who have an overall final yearly average of 90 or higher in their core subjects of Math, Science, Reading, History, and English. The student should be of worthy character, credible achievement, and commendable attitude.
6. A member will be required to pay local dues of \$10.00 and a one time National Membership fee of \$16.00.
7. A member of this chapter of the Beta Club may be dropped from membership if he/she is consistently absent from meetings or his scholastic record falls below an 88 average. Each member will be re-evaluated at the end of the academic year. The student must maintain a cumulative overall average of 88 in all core classes to remain a member.
8. The Principal may drop a member for moral or disciplinary reasons that are deemed, by him, to be sufficient.
9. As soon as possible after the fall semester of the school year, this chapter of the Beta Club will undertake a program of service which will be of benefit to the Paradise Junior High School.
10. Members shall be drawn from 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade classes.
11. The officers of this chapter shall be: a president, a vice president, a secretary, a treasurer and a reporter. Officers must be selected from current 8<sup>th</sup> grade members that have been in the club for 1 year and are in good standing.
