English Language Proficiency Standards (ELPS) Academies

Teachers will explore ways to increase achievement for English language learners using the English Language Proficiency Standards (ELPS). The ELPS require specific focus on developing academic language in the content areas through reading, writing, speaking, and listening in grades K-12. In each content session, participants will examine the ELPS and will practice writing language objectives using the four domains. The resources provided in training contain specific strategies that will enable teachers to incorporate the ELPS in their classrooms. Teachers may attend more than one ELPS content-area academy. However, *the stipend will only be awarded for the first content-area attended.*
